Chief's Report, Board Meeting 05/09/2017

- Sheriff Office has started being more proactive about bike races. I have been told that they are soon starting to enforce county rules on race management.
 Generally, we should see an increase in bike races going through our canyon and Cty Rd 83. I received several inquiries during and after the last race to prohibit races, which of course is not something I could do even if I wanted to. Which I don't. But racing will pick up and we need to stay on the county for enforcement during and after the permitting process.
- We are working on having more firefighters trained on driving all engines to a scene. A tedious project but
 of the essence to ensure future response as we are slim on firefighters to drive and operate engines. A
 driver taskbook was developed and implemented three years ago, and a pump taskbook is currently being
 revised.
- 3. Department SOG's are being developed and expected to be ready for officer review by this summer.
- 4. Sunshine was granted an Opticom system (sets lights in town green when going emergent) by the City of Boulder for faster 4561 response whenever reasonable (at my discretion). The system was installed in my POV. We were able to get it at a significantly lower cost after requesting the City Fire Chief and Transportation Department to allow it having explained the benefits to the City for us having one (I contacted him three days after the Sunshine Fire). We were never eligible for it since our district is not adjacent to the City and they have a general "no mountain district" rule when it comes to the system but seem to be loser about it now than in the past, which makes sense.
- 5. I am hoping to get an answer from this which I brought up in March (though not personally): We have had several issues in the last year of compromised safety during night time roadside operations, in one case a vehicle ignoring the road stop and going right through the scene (with no additional incident). Other departments have done this, and I would also like to provide our officers with high visibility jackets specific for fire that are also used during EMS calls etc. They cost \$295 each and we have nine people that require them.
- 6. Sunshine (4561 and 4565 in 4532) was the first responding agency for the fatal bike accident last Thursday. A memorial service is scheduled for 05/09 at 10am and all responders were invited by the family.
